Open University Courses at the University of Oulu

The Software Engineering and Information Systems (SEIS) -degree programme is offering to XUT- students a possibility to take up to four University of Oulu Master's level courses. The courses are provided in distant education form, and (at the moment) for free.

If you pass 3 of these 4 courses with the average grade of at least 3 (of 5), you are eligible to the SEIS Master's programme via the "Open Path" (Selection Method 1: Open University Studies), without normal selection process. Via this method, 30 students can be selected. If you will start your studies in SEIS programme, these passed courses will be already included in your master's degree studies.

- The courses are normal UO Master's level courses
- You study together with the UO students
- The courses are studied in UO Moodle learning environment
- The course requirements and teaching are the same as for UO students
- All 4 courses are given in the autumn semester 2024
- Enrolment to all four courses is open now in Open University registration system: <u>https://opiskelemaan.peppi.oulu.fi/</u>
- Please do not delay the enrolment because the courses are filling up fast.
